

COVID-19 Vaccine Dosage Guide

Pfizer

Ages 12 and older

Dose 1

Dosage: 0.3 mL



Dose 2

Dosage: 0.3 mL



Given at least 21 days after Dose 1

Dose 3

Dosage: 0.3 mL



Recommended for moderately and severely immuno-compromised people

Given at least 28 days after Dose 2

Booster Dose

Dosage: 0.3 mL



Recommended at least 5 months after the last dose of an mRNA vaccine

May also receive Moderna half dose (0.25 mL) after an initial Pfizer vaccine series

Pfizer Pediatric

Ages 5-11

Dose 1

Dosage: 0.2 mL



Dose 2

Dosage: 0.2 mL



Given at least 21 days after Dose 1

Dose 3

Dosage: 0.2 mL



Recommended for moderately and severely immuno-compromised children

Given at least 28 days after Dose 2

Moderna

Ages 18 and older

Dose 1

Dosage: 0.5 mL

Dose 2

Dosage: 0.5 mL

Given at least 28 days after Dose 1

Dose 3

Dosage: 0.5 mL

Recommended for moderately and severely immuno-compromised people

Given at least 28 days after Dose 2

Booster Dose

Dosage: 0.25 mL

Recommended at least 5 months after the last dose of an mRNA vaccine

May also receive Pfizer dose (0.3 mL) after an initial Moderna vaccine series

Johnson & Johnson

Ages 18 and older

Dose 1

Dosage: 0.5 mL

Booster Dose

Dosage: 0.5 mL

Recommended at least 2 months after initial J&J dose

May also receive Pfizer dose (0.3 mL) or Moderna half dose (0.25 mL) after initial J&J vaccine

Pfizer Cap Key



Gray Cap

If dose from gray cap is given, no diluent is required



Purple Cap

If dose from purple cap is given, 1.8 mL of diluent is required



Orange Cap

If dose from orange cap is given, 1.3 mL of diluent is required
